Visit The Rock Ranch for Family Events This Spring -

Strawberry Pickin', Easter Egg Hunts and Spring Break Fun

WHAT: The Rock Ranch will open to the public on March 24, beginning the spring season at the farm. Guests can enjoy events such as the Easter Eggstravaganza, 7th Annual Strawberry Festival, and Spring Saturdays.

- **TGIF on the Farm | March 24, 31, April 7, 21 | 10 am- 4 pm**
Catering to students on Spring Break or guests with younger children, these days offer more than 35 attractions including Farm Land petting zoo, Cow-a-Bunga zip lines, cane pole fishing, pony rides, and shopping in the Georgia Grown Farm Market. Tickets are \$12/tax.
- **Easter Eggstravaganza | April 8 | 11 am – 4 pm**
A free event offering an Easter egg hunt for 45,000 prize-filled eggs, photo opportunities with the Easter Bunny, and Bible story time with a local pastor. Wristbands are available for purchase to enjoy more activities on the farm for \$8, or individual attraction passes are available.
- **7th Annual Strawberry Festival | April 22 | 10 am – 5 pm**
Experiences include strawberry picking, photos with Strawberry Shortcake and the Strawberry Princess, 35+ farm attractions, live music, homemade strawberry treats, and the Georgia Grown Farm Market. Tickets are \$15/tax.
- **Spring Saturdays | April 29, May 6 | 10 am – 4 pm**
Explore the farm and more than 35 attractions including Tiny Town (a miniature themed playhouse village), locomotive train, giant jumping pillow, and a Georgia Grown Farmers Market. Tickets are \$12/tax.
